
CIRCULAR

Following instructions are hereby issued for improving the management of COVID-19 cases in all Government and Private Medical College attached Hospitals of the State:

1. Non essential elective surgeries shall be deferred.
2. To ramp up spare capacity of wards and ICUs, no more admission of patients shall be made except for emergencies.
3. Existing patients admitted in hospital IPDs shall be screened by treating Doctors under the guidance of HOD to see that they can be discharged as early as possible. This will make vacant beds available for any kind of emergency.
4. A common ward can be developed where all patients who still need to be kept in IPD may be kept. PMC may decide capacity of this ward in consultation with respective Superintendents.
5. Separate OPD should be developed for ILI patients. This should be segregated from the remaining OPDs or emergency.
6. To reduce chances of infection through congested OPDs, OPD in department like Skin, etc may be suspended till 31st May 2021.
7. Doctors and Para-medical staff of any speciality may be deployed for OPD, IPD and other duties related to Covid-19 treatment. PMCs are authorized to issue orders in this regard.
8. All different units of respective departments shall be merged and will act as one unit in each department.


